

Video 31: Important Message from Wes and Ariel (Transcript)

Ariel and I would like to make a statement regarding our videos. For those who have read the Wes Penre Papers (WPP) at wespenre.com will know how I work and how I present things, but for those who are fairly unfamiliar with my previous work will not know. Therefore, I want to explain how this video project is setup.

This video series is built in the exact same manner as the WPP, i.e. Ariel and I post things as we go along. We have a general idea of what we want to publish, based on previous work we've done together, but the particular videos often contain information that we have gathered through recent research and from bouncing ideas and insights between each other. In other words, we learn as we go along, and we publish as we learn. It's a little bit like sitting in on a livestream and hear our insights taking form, expanding on previous knowledge and insights that we've had. We are, to a large degree, connecting dots on an intuitive level, but still basing it on what we've previously learned. Therefore, the viewers will be able to follow our own progress and epiphanies as we move on—it's like being able to follow our research and cognitive insights more or less in present time.

The implications of this are twofold. First, epiphanies and cognitive insights often come from a higher perspective of Self, which is not always possible to achieve only by "scientific research." What usually happens when these epiphanies come to us is that the bigger picture makes more sense, many questions we had previously are now getting answered, and the overall perspective broadens. Second, although our experience has been that in the majority of these cases, it brings the overall comprehension of a topic forward and the picture gets clearer, but at times, there are some details that later need to be adjusted, corrected, or expanded upon. When this is the case, we will make follow-up videos on the related topic, including the new information.

This way of working that has been very successful for me personally in the past as well, and to my delight, I quickly noticed that Ariel's mind works in an identical fashion. Often, what Ariel and I conclude can be verified by other people's research in form of documents, experiences, and testimonies, etc., but sometimes this is not possible because there is no research done on it. When this is the case, and we both can see that our insights enhance the bigger picture, we publish it. And, as mentioned above, if we later need to change details, we do that, but we still keep the original information available on YouTube.

We have decided to do it this way, so that the viewers can see how we came to our conclusions, and how our overall picture broadens as we move forward on our journey. Thus, we are not going to wait until we have a grasp of an entire topic before we post—our comprehension and our conclusions will come in increments. Part of this decision is also based upon the fact that as human beings in this reality, there is no end to learning. The way we look at things today might therefore not always be the same way we will look at things a few years from now, or even sooner than that. We, working in this manner, speed up our learning process tremendously, as we have noticed, so we hope our way of working will be to the benefit of many viewers as well. We both find it very exciting and rewarding to do our project this way.

Lastly, Ariel and I want to stress how much we appreciate your comments to our videos!!! If you have your own thoughts, experiences, or have done your own research on these subjects, we would be very happy if you share this with us and other viewers. We learn from each other! Also, if you have questions or comments directed toward our work, write them down in the comment section, too, and we will try to reply to those to the best of our ability. This is much better than email because here on YouTube, everybody can participate and learn from each other's thoughts and insights.
