

Video 54: Have there Been Breaches of Freewill? (Transcript)

First, both Ariel and I love the comments you posted on the previous video, discussing what you think should be done about this Experiment of Freewill! We both feel that we need to open this YouTube forum for discussion—it's utterly important. Thank you, and please continue in the same spirit! Also, Ariel and I can see what our visitors have on their minds and what they are wondering about. This gives us new ideas for subjects or sub-subjects we might be able to address in future videos. This video is such an example.

The question raised in this video title is if there have been any breaches of freewill by the Overlords since the Invasion. If we look at different horrific things that are being done towards us, and all the horrific things we humans are doing towards each other, knowing that above all this, the Overlords are pulling their strings, it's easy to answer this question with a loud "YES!" However, things are a little bit shadier than that. All this time, the Overlords have done the best they can to NOT violate freewill but still get it their way. But, realistically, have they actually violated freewill? Maybe, maybe not—to be determined. Nonetheless, we have been subjected to severe manipulation at the least, so let's look at how things really work in an Experiment of Freewill.

The entire purpose with the freewill experiment was to see whether it would result in better creator gods, who can create with more wisdom, compassion, love, and cooperation. It is not that creator gods in the KHAA can't accomplish this in other ways, but the Queen wanted to speed up the process of evolution in the KHAA, so that more souls can become creator gods faster and with more first-hand experiences in all kinds of creation. Therefore, we humans are allowed to create freely, without boundaries, and with NO strings attached (this is VERY important—no strings attached).

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A big misconception when it comes to freewill is that we humans can't interfere with other people's freewill. This is not the case, and this is where "no strings attached" comes into the equation. We, the human soul group, can create what we want, regardless whether it's "evil" or "good." Therefore, you might have a great idea that will benefit many people and you start creating on it, but I have the right to create something that counteracts this or even destroys your creation. This does NOT violate freewill, so long as you're a part of the human experiment. This does NOT apply to outside forces. However, there are consequences to whatever we create.

What the Queen wanted to see was that if people were free to create from any emotional state, would that eventually change the way a person creates? If you have a great idea, and someone comes and prevents you from applying it, how will you react? While immature, maybe retaliation will be your "solution," and conflicts and consequences will emerge from that. The hope was that over time, humans would mature and start thinking, "if I respond to this 'attack' with a revengeful action, will this benefit me, the perpetrator, other people around me, or even the entire soul group, or will it make things worse?" When a person realizes that responding and reacting to a negative intention from someone else will not benefit anyone, he or she will start creating in a different way—he or she becomes clever. The person figures out how to create great things without having to be interfered by other people's counter-intentions. The hope was that we eventually would include other things, such as the environment, a group of people, and perhaps even the entire soul group's expansion in our intentions and creations, so that what we want can benefit as many as possible. We would make plans how to bypass lower frequency intentions—both from ourselves and from others. Thus, we will create without being affected by "distractions." Simply put, we would become much wiser creator **gods**.

In summary, the purpose was to see if we, from having experienced every possible emotions thought of, and at the same time being free to create

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from any of those emotions, managed to raise ourselves to a point where we can gain wisdom from our experiences and create to the benefit of oneself, one’s group, and as much as possible with the benefit of the entire Universe in mind. Some of this must be lacking out in the KHAA. If this Experiment would succeed, it would speed up and enhance the quality of what future creator gods are creating for others in the Universe.

The crux is that our soul group were supposed to be left here alone to hopefully achieve this goal, without any interference from beings outside of the construct that had been created for us by other creator gods, with the Queen as an overseer. Outside beings were not allowed to mate with humans because that would contaminate the Experiment. This was done anyway by whom the Bible calls the “Fallen Angels,” and they were held accountable for this (see the Wes Penre Papers). In the past, after the initial Fallen Angels were captured and penalized, more gods were walking around here on Earth in human bodies, mating with humans left and right. This is something they must be held accountable for. It’s a no-no for star beings to mate with humans. However, this is something different—it’s not a breach of freewill, except when they rape women, which IS a breach of freewill. And some of the gods DID rape Earth women.

When we see all the terrible things that have been and are being “done to us,” it’s easy to immediately say that freewill has been violated—the splitting of souls in the BLA is only one of myriads of examples. However, what we fail to take into consideration is what it was that led us to the point where the gods considered it being okay to treat us in such ways. If we trace it back, we’re going to see that we incrementally agreed to having this happen to us. On the gods’ part, this was done via manipulation, and we can strongly disagree to that this would be a valid reason to abuse us, but that’s not the point here. The point is whether we made freewill CHOICES that led us to a certain negative experience. What if we’d made other choices? We might say that this is not fair, but this experiment is not about fairness—it has its set of rules that are to be followed, i.e. “anything goes.” It’s up to us to make the right decisions. Even when we make decisions that are not beneficial to us, we are creator gods, and it’s our responsibility to make a better choice that will remedy any damage that

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has been done. This is absolutely possible, but not with a population that is **asleep**.

Manipulation is a nasty thing—particularly in the way it’s been done. Humanity is following the Overlords’ agenda almost to the letter, thinking everything is fine. It’s cleverly done because we are being embedded in a false sense of freedom. The WingMakers say that the deepest and strongest program that has been implanted in humankind is the fear of death—a fear of the unknown. We agree with this. Therefore, humans are constantly fighting to survive, not understanding that there is no death. But the illusion of death, and the fear thereof, is the reason why we need governments and the society to take care of us. They give us an illusion of freedom when they tell us that if we elect them, they will take care of us, give us a job, food on the table, a roof over our heads, so-called healthcare, and money to buy our necessities. This makes us feel more safe and secure, and death seems farther away. This is also why it’s so difficult to break people’s programming—they are afraid to stand on their own feet, when they know that they have their basics cared for by the “authorities,” whom we often elect to their positions. People don’t want to change because of fear. This is also why humanity is so easy to manipulate because from this position, the “authorities” can control us and manipulate us as they wish, and we will go along with it, so long as they provide for us. Still, it all started with that we agreed to letting the Overlords use their Minions to control us, and after that, one thing led to another. We gave our power away, and they are feeding from it.

We can go on and on and blame the Queen, the Overlords, and their Minions for the situation we are in, but it doesn’t take away our own responsibility in the matter. That doesn’t put the blame on us, either, it just states a sober fact. We created this mess for ourselves in an Experiment of Freewill, with a lot of “help” from the Overlords, but we humans are the ones who are CREATING. En.ki and his cohorts are not creating anything—they let US do it, taking advantage of our freewill to create whatever they want—with our permission. The Overlords are just coming with “suggestions,” if we look at it crassly.

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To understand this entire situation, we MUST be able to look at it from a much higher, cosmic perspective. If we get stuck in unfairness, blame, and bitterness, we will never become creator gods out in the KHAA. This is exactly what the Queen was trying to remedy with this experiment. We are responsible for our own actions, regardless when we're manipulated or not, and this is what makes us adults. Instead of going into a games condition with the gods and their Minions, we need to start learning how to create from love, compassion, and cooperation. We don't want to go out there in the KHAA in a worse shape than when we started out. It might or might not be too late to save the entire soul group, but even if this is not doable, as many as possible can exit the Matrix with our creator god abilities intact and enhanced, but it's up to the individual. The Overlords' problems are their problems, and they need to deal with them, while we deal with **ours**.

With this mindset, we can graduate as mature creators, instead of being a liability to the universe around us—here as well as in the KHAA. If the Overlords will be caught or surrender, they will go on trial in Orion, and their fate will be decided there. If they refuse to surrender, their days are numbered anyway. Why not let them play out and take responsibility for THEIR actions together with their Minions, and we'll take responsibility for ours? Regardless how we twist and turn it, we humans did this to ourselves, and now it is affecting the rest of the Universe, too.

By all this, we are not saying that breaches of freewill have not been made, but we need to define the term in the first place, and then we need to look at all this from a Higher Mind before we can make an accurate assessment.
