Video 69: Elon Musk's Singularity (Transcript) Written by Wes Penre, September 11, 2018

First, an update—one of our viewers has donated a professional microphone and software to our project, and these items will arrive in a couple of days or so. Because of this, the sound quality of these videos should increase, so please bear with us...

We would assume that most people who are drawn to these videos know what the Singularity is, so we are not going to get into explaining that here in any great detail. If you haven't heard about it, and if you don't know much about it, there is a lot of information out there on the subject. I also wrote a book on this subject that can be downloaded for free on my website, wespenre.com.

The other day, I watched a video, in which Joe Rogan interviewed Elon Musk, and it seems like a few people who visit our channel watched it, too. Ariel and I think it's appropriate to bring up Elon Musk's agenda here for clarification, in case you haven't seen through it yet.

As we already know, AI and the Singularity are well in progress of being played out right now—people all over the world are rapidly and ignorantly drawn into it. As Elon Musk said in the interview, "We already ARE cyborgs." By this, he meant that we are already merging with

technology—totally dependent upon smartphones, computers, and the Internet. We are more and more drawn into this artificial new construct, and we live less and less in our biological world.

Before we continue, let us define what the Singularity will entail. I explained in my book that the human body will be made more or less immortal, by replacing our biological body parts with technology; e.g. when an organ in our body is malfunctioning, we can replace it with an organ that runs on nanobots. This will be a great hook for many people because the fear of death is probably the most basic implant in our bodies and our minds, like James Mahu of the WingMakers **proposes**.

That's the bodily aspect of the Singularity—the message is that we never again need to die. The mind/spiritual aspect of it is the Internet. As it is now, the Internet is something external from us—we need to use computers or smartphones, etc. to get access to it. In the Singularity Era, the Internet becomes the Innernet. There will no longer be any need for computers or smartphones—all that will become internal. The so-called "Supercomputer," which will include all our common thoughts, knowledge, information, creation, and so on, will be inside of us. With assistance from AI, we will be able to connect with anybody at anytime, all around the world, in the speed of thought, via a "cloud," which is the Innernet—no more typing, no more booting computers, and no more slow connections. Our current Internet will of course be refined, so that the transmissions will be seamless. Elon Musk says, and I paraphrase; "We

still have a bandwidth problem, but when that is resolved, we're more or less good to go."

AI already have their own cloud, through which they can communicate instantly. If one AI unit in the United States wants to communicate with another AI unit in Japan, they can communicate instantly back and forth, and the scary part is that, according to the Singularitists, we humans no longer have access to this AI cloud, meaning that we don't know what AI is communicating between each other.

So, in the nearby future, we will have the Internet inside our heads, and no equipment is necessary. We can also, with this new artificial mind, control our home equipment, our cars, airplanes, and what have you. Many people will think that all these solutions are wonderful, and they will go for it! Little do they understand that by integrating all this technology into the human body and mind, we will be trapped forever, and completely under the Overlords' control. They will have total control over our minds.

In all this, what is Elon Musk's agenda? First, we must realize that the Global Elite has a nearly complete understanding of how the human mind works, and they know exactly how to control it, manipulate it, and get what they want. What they basically want right now is our consent, and this is where Elon Musk comes into the **picture**.

On one hand, we have spokespersons, such as Ray Kurzweil, whose mission is to present AI and the Singularity to the human soul group in an enthusiastic manner. He repeats over and over how humanity would clearly benefit from the Singularity. And he makes sure that people understand that the Singularity is inevitable; it WILL happen, and it is planned to be in place by 2045.

However, having a great comprehension of how the human mind works, the Elite knows that they also need to create an opposition, so they can win over those who are on the fence regarding the Singularity, but also to win over those in the alternative field—people like us. Therefore, assets like Elon Musk (EL like in Elohim?) and physicist Michio Kaku are appointed—both being part of the Singularity agenda to begin with.

Michio Kaku is a scientist that is perfect to use for this agenda. For years, he's been the "scientist for the people," showing up everywhere in the news and on talk shows, explaining complicated science in a comprehensible manner. He is very enthusiastic and friendly in his appearance, so he attracts a huge audience, who thinks that finally there is a scientist that is dedicating himself to us, the people, so we can understand all these complexities.

Some time ago, I watched a video with Kaku, where he had gathered a big audience, announcing that he had something important to say, and it was on AI. In this briefing, he said that since the beginning, he had been very

outspoken against both AI and the Singularity. However, after having pondered this a lot, he'd now concluded that AI and the Singularity is probably the way to go. Then, he listed all the advantages the Singularity would have, and he did it in his usual enthusiastic, bonding way. When he was done, he got an amazingly positive response from his audience, who saluted him greatly. This is how they hook people.

Elon Musk works in a very similar way. For years, he proclaimed that AI and the Singularity would be the end of humankind, and it needs to be opposed at any cost. By doing so, pretending to be the "billionaire for the people," he has gained a lot of followers over the years. In this last interview with Joe Rogan, however, Musk has completely changed his mind.

In this interview (see Description box for URL), Musk—intentionally so, we would suggest—looked sad and down, and he had a very serious look on his face. He said that he'd tried to warn people against AI all this time, but never gotten the response he'd hoped for. He had talked to politicians and other people at the higher echelons of society, but he'd been completely ignored. Hence, Musk's conclusion is that AI and the Singularity can't be stopped, so instead of uselessly fighting against it, we should all join it instead—"If you can't fight it, join it," as he put it.

However, to get as many people on his side as possible, he also announced that he and his team are developing their own version of the Singularity

that in his mind would be better than the mainstream version. He said that probably in a couple of months from now, his team will be able to release some ground-breaking information about where they are in the process right now.

I hope you can see how this works. Be very aware of people who are allowed airtime on CNN and CBS News, mainstream talk shows, etc., speaking up against what the Elite wants to accomplish. No one, who is not part of the agenda, will get airtime on the mainstream news channels. Although it might seem like that those who propagate against the harmful agendas are on our side, just watch and see—over time we will notice that they were opposing it in order to win over people on their side, only to later change their minds and sway people over to the original agenda.

This technique has always been very successful, and a majority of the population will fall for it. And when the Singularity has been fully implemented in society, those who refuse to be part of it will be allowed to have that choice, but their lives will be very inconvenient. They will have no access to the Smart Cities that are completely built to fit the Singularity. You can't function in these cities without your Innernet. In the beginning, many opponents to the Singularity will live in rural areas or off the grid, but in the long run, most of them will get tired of the inconvenience to always having to work on bypassing all the new laws that will come into effect, making it very difficult not to be part of the scheme. This is when people will remember trigger phases like, "If you can't fight them, join them." They will give up and join. There is no

coincidence that Musk uses this phrase over and over—it sticks in the subconscious mind and will surface when times get rough.

There is also a reason why critical thinking is not taught in school anymore. It's this critical thinking we need to use now—more than ever before—or we will be fooled into joining the Singularity in one way or another. Using critical thinking also includes not to follow anybody as if that person or group is the authority. We need to learn to be authentic and use our own inner power and discernment in every situation, or we'll be manipulated. Research and learn, but always use critical thinking. Most of the world population doesn't.
