# Video 155: THE BIG PICTURE SERIES PART 14 Wheel of Time—How does Time Work?

f there is something we humans are confused about, it's the concept of time. What is time, and how does it work?

Time, simply put, is movement of particles in space. What we call space is the

Time, simply put, is movement of particles in space. What we call space is the perceived distance between particles, which creates different locations or points of view. For space to exist, there must be more than One of something, otherwise there is no distance, and thus, no space, and there would be no time, either.

We hear in the metaphysical community that all time is simultaneous. How does that work? We humans only know of linear time (more or less). What is the difference?

Let's start with linear time. The reason we experience time as linear is because of our extremely limited perceptions—our five senses. In these physical bodies and our synthetic light-bodies we can only perceive a micro-bit of the entire electromagnetic spectrum. This is how this Construct/Patrix is built, per design.

What happens when we have a thought, an intention, and make a decision/choice? In this very dense "reality," things move very slowly. It takes "time" between our thoughts and intentions and the manifestation of those intentions. There is space and time passing before we get the product, and often, some physical work is required. This makes it feel like time has passed in a linear fashion; we are constantly moving into a future with an unknown or uncertain outcome. Instead of being confident that we will get what we create in our mind, and because time is passing between thought and manifestation (like walking through glue), so many obstacles could potentially come in between. If someone doesn't like your creation, there is plenty of time to set up obstacles and stops, and it becomes more difficult to get things done because of counter-intentions and objections from others and from this solid material world. Therefore, we can almost never be completely sure about the consequences of our intentions. The future becomes uncertain.

Because time here seems to pass so slowly, compared to the KHAA, we seem to be moving on a linear timeline. This also gives us the illusion of that there is a past time. We can't see that all time is happening simultaneously. In addition, the Overlords

made this Patrix into a "Construct of Death"—everything here dies, without exception. This further emphasizes the illusion of linear time.

So, how does time work in the KHAA—in the Greater Universe if time is simultaneous?

We hear that we live in a Multiverse that is fluid, where nothing is set in stone—everything happens at the same time. This is true, but most humans can't think along these lines because we're so used to our linear way of thinking.

Let's start with a metaphor that we like a lot! We found this metaphor in a blog post by Adriaan de Rijk called, "Is it All an Illusion?<sup>1</sup>" (link in the description box below), and we found it being excellent in order to explain this in a relatively simple way:

"Seen from an exterior viewpoint we can become aware of an uncountable number of Events that seem to happen all at once. Much like flying above a big city. If you look down from the plane you can see enormous activity consisting of uncountable Events happening at the same time.

If you are riding your bike in that same city you can still become aware of several Events happening at the same time. If you go sit in that city on a terrace and you talk to someone only that Event and probably some of your surroundings form part of your existence.

What you see is what you get. Or to be more precise, what you are aware of exists. A viewpoint is a point from which you view. We, as spirits or souls, are all unique because we assume viewpoints different from each other."

In the KHAA, we have the freedom to create instantly with our thoughts, intentions, and imagination. At least, this apply to star beings who have left their home planet or home star and are free to roam the KHAA, travelling with thought alone in the nano-world. In the Wes Penre Papers (WPP), I called this "nano-travel." There is no relevant time passing between thought and manifestation, or travel through apparent distances—these things happen quite instantaneously. There is no linear time involved in these **processes**.

If we would be able to look at the KHAA—and even our own Construct—from a time perspective, and from above, with all star beings included, we could compare it to a huge wheel with spokes—a symbolism that has also been used consistently in different Mystery Schools throughout time. Let's say that the inhabited dimensions are in the middle of the wheel; all these beings are emanating thoughts and intentions. As soon as someone has a thought, that thought branches out through all these spokes that represent all possible probabilities that can manifest from that thought—it happens instantly. We are creating a huge number of probabilities with just one thought and one intention. We humans tend to make a choice from the

probabilities we can think of from our limited perspective, when in reality, there are a lot more options to choose from, if we were only more aware. Like one of my contacts said, and I paraphrase: "In the KHAA, if we make an intention, we can send out fires to other dimensions to try to find the best probable outcome, and then we choose that." In other words, our thoughts and intentions, and to some degree, the manifestations of those, are all created at the same time.

Does this mean that everything is predestined? No, there are always unknown factors, depending on what we want to accomplish—even in the KHAA. Even there, someone else can cross-create and counter-create whatever a star being is creating, but out there, things are much more instant, and less obstacles are preventing them from achieving their goal.

In this Construct, the Overlords are doing whatever they can to keep us under their control. They are, to a large degree, the "unknown factor" because we can't see them. Because of this, they have the upper hand—at least so long as we don't know that these gods exist and what their intentions are. Here on Earth, there is more predestiny than there is complete freewill because we are limited in our choices, and these choices can be manipulated. On a good day, we might still choose the best probability we can perceive, but most of these "best probabilities/choices" can be manipulated, leading us to something that benefits the Overlords in the long run, rather than it does us. We need to remember that they, too, have freewill, and as well as we have choices, so do they. We need to realize this, and not until then can we learn to make decisions that are genuinely our own.

Channeled beings often say that a problem the Overlords have with us is our unpredictability—our uncertainties, which stem from limited perspectives. This often makes us change our minds in the middle of a process, and this is an unfortunate consequence from the Overlords' perspective. It makes it harder for them. However, or so they hope, this will be resolved with the Singularity, where they much easier can get people on the same page and on the same timeline.

Regardless of what decisions we made in the "past," we can change our direction at any time by making new choices. This alters the timelines/probabilities we created earlier because we changed our minds. I remember the Pleiadians saying that by healing ourselves in the present, we also heal our ancestral line backwards in time in relation to the healing we're going through now. This might be difficult to understand, but that's where the fluidity of this Multiverse comes into play. We can literally change events in the past by radically change our behavior in the present—the Pleiadians called it "healing along the lines of time." Some listeners might now ponder about our history; which history is true, and which is not? Because Creation is an illusion, coming from our imagination, beliefs, and belief systems, we can change what we consider our past, and even our future, which we will come to in a minute.

Regarding healing along the lines of time, let's take an example. Have you ever been in a serious accident, or has something happened in your past that could have been

fatal if you weren't "lucky?" Have you ever "miraculously" been "saved," and afterwards you thought, "how did I manage to get through that?" Maybe you thought it was a "guardian  $\mathbf{angel}$ ?"

Here is a thought: let's say that today you're asking your Higher Self for protection, and you say something to the effect, "I am protected—always!" Would it not be possible that you, after that, might not just be protected in what you perceive as present time, but also in the past? Could your miraculous escape from an early death in an accident fifteen years ago have had anything to do with that you asked for protection today? Did you change the outcome of the past incident in the now? Just something to think about.

This concept can only be understood if we grasp that everything is just a big present—there is no past and no future—it's just a big NOW. Our reality is only based on where our focus goes, and what we focus on is the density/reality we perceive ourselves to live in. Therefore, a single person can change they own timeline by thinking it. Also, every thought they have about the future makes it probable to happen, and if the thought is strong (negative or positive), there is a big possibility that it will happen on their own timeline. However, they can, at any time, change that thought and intention, and the future that was already created will now be altered. That's why we emphasize that we are responsible for our own thoughts and choices—no one else can change your path the way you want it to go, except you.

We all have our own timeline with many, many other potential timelines "floating" in parallel to your own. You can at any time switch timelines and choose another, often already established timeline.

On top of this, we have a main, agreed-upon timeline that we have been manipulated into believing has happened to everybody, which is not true! Well, it becomes more and more true the more people believe it.

Does this mean that the history timeline we have learned about in school can be made undone? Can we even dissolve the event when the Invasion of Tiamaat happened? Can we change our destiny by just disagreeing and alter our perspective and our viewpoints? Because everything in this Multiverse is fluid, we would suggest, yes! Potentially, we could, if all of us, or most of us, undid a certain event, such as the Invasion of Tiamaat, in our minds as a collective. If we did that, what would happen? Our timelines would change, and En.ki's Patrix would, from our perspective, never have happened. The consequences of this would be that we would be free! The only entrapment we are experiencing is the one in our own minds!

If this is true, why can't you and I, who know these things, just erase that timeline? It's because we are interwoven with each other—all of us in this Human Soul Group are. We have a mass consciousness, which is captured within the Grid. We can imagine it as being tentacles of energy going between us like a gigantic energetic spider web, where we all are connected. If we think of it in these terms, we can see

why it's not a piece of cake to break free in here—particularly not while we're in our physical bodies and have our metaphysical synthetic soul, which keeps us tied to this Patrix. Without that, we are as free as the wind. This is the reason why exiting the Grid after death works! You can't do it while in this body. Once out of the Grid, you are no longer connected to the human mass consciousness, which is captured here in En.ki's Construct.

There are also things called "vertical time" and "cyclic time" that we have not mentioned here, but that will be for another video.
